This exclusive weekend, designed for a small group to get the most out of the retreat, will deliver the following program (this is an anticipated program only, we do have some flexibility within this based on the unique requirements of the group):

- Arrival – any time from 3pm onwards on Friday December 10. It's important that you let Alex know what your expected ETA is. If you wish to arrive earlier, this can be arranged.
- Dinner will be served based on your arrival time on Friday. Depending on when you plan to arrive we will do a group breathing / meditation session either prior to, or after dinner.
- Saturday December 11 – we will do three sessions of yoga during the day. This will allow you to have some free time to relax or explore the area. We have some beautiful walks near the Lodge so please bring some shoes to walk in!
- Sunday December 12 – we will do two yoga sessions. Departure on Sunday will be around 2pm.

All attendees will get a one-on-one session with Vincent included as part of the weekend's schedule. These individual sessions allow you to focus on specific areas of your practice, or for meditation coaching. Please let us know what time during the weekend you would like to schedule your session and we will confirm your time slot on Friday after you arrive.

Activities in the area include: walks to the beautiful Cathedral Cove, bush walks around Shakespeare Cliff, digging hot pools in the sand at Hot Water Beach, golf, surfing - or just relax in the Lodge hot tub or with a good book in the Lodge library.

All meals are included (served communally in the Lodge Room), plus pre-dinner drinks with our compliments (please BYO if you wish to have wine with meals). Accommodation is on a shared basis (2 per room). All yoga sessions are included (also includes your private / one-on-one session).

IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Please let Alex know what your expected arrival time will be on Friday December 10.
- If you have any special dietary requirements, please let us know at least 4 days prior to the retreat. We focus on serving unprocessed meals that are all made in the Lodge kitchen so we can attend to most requirements.
- Please bring swimming costumes if you wish to use the Lodge hot tub – it's a great way to relax in the evenings!
- Bring some shoes suitable for walking if you wish to explore the area (running shoes or similar will be fine).
- Bring your yoga mat and any yoga gear or equipment you usually practice with (please let us know if you don't have a mat so we can provide you with one).
- Bring some warm clothes as we so early morning sessions on the beach if the weather permits.
- Please let us know what time during the weekend you would like to schedule your one-on-one session with Vincent and we will confirm your time slot on Friday after you arrive.

Driving Directions to Shakespeare Cliff Lodge & Retreat

Directions from Auckland - Heading from Auckland city, travel down the southern motorway and take the exit after the Bombay Hills to Thames / Coromandel Peninsula (SH2). Continue and turn left onto SH25 to Coromandel Peninsula. Stay on SH25 road until you get to Kopu (just after the long one-way bridge with lights on it) and turn right at the T-Junction by the Caltex petrol station. About 1km later, take the first left, across the Coromandel ranges heading towards Tairua on the Kopu / Hikuai road (SH25A). Go through Tairua and head over the Tairua hill on the Tairua / Whitianga road. Turn off at Whenuakite about 5km's after the Tairua Hill heading towards Hot Water Beach / Hahei / Cooks Beach. Cooks Beach is well sign

posted from there. You can't miss the Lodge - it's straight behind Cooks Beach on the left hand side before you reach the Cooks Beach turnoff. You need to go to the big Tuscan style house up on the hill above the vineyards. The trip will take you about 2.5 hours from Auckland. The address is 745 Purangi Road, Cooks Beach.
